14 Describe the organizational action and, if applicable, the date of the action or the date against which shareholders' ownership is measured for the action ▶ Credit Suisse Emerging Markets Equity Fund (the "Fund") paid a final dividend to its shareholders on August 29, 2017 in the per share amounts set forth on the attached schedule. In January 2018, the Fund determined that its earnings and profits for the final fiscal year ending September 1, 2017 were insufficient to characterize the full amount of this distribution to shareholders as a dividend under IRC section 301(c). As a result of this determination, a portion of this distribution has been characterized as a return of capital.

Effect on Cost Basis
